**Billing, Schedules, and Grades:** Tuition and fees are due two weeks prior to the first day of the semester. RVCC does not send paper bills or schedules. Upon registration, you are enrolled unless otherwise notified. No confirmation will be mailed. Classes are subject to change. Students need to login to the Student Information System (SIS) for their E-bills, schedule, classroom location(s), grades, financial aid information, student email account, etc.

**Course Offering Options:** In addition to traditional face-to-face class meetings, RVCC offers courses in a variety of modalities to meet student needs. Online courses have no scheduled meeting times. Online courses are asynchronous and delivered via Canvas. While students can complete assignments at a time that fits their schedules, online classes have expectations including, but not limited to, regular and substantive faculty and student participation and assignment due dates. Remote Synchronous courses meet at designated times through Zoom. There is also a selection of Hybrid options available to maximize flexibility and while offering synchronous opportunities to learn. When courses are listed as Synch. & Asynch. Online, there will be contact hours completed both together on Zoom and separately online. When the course location is listed as a town and Asynch. Online, you will meet face-to-face at the designated times with the remainder of the course taught asynchronously. Flex options allow the student to choose between multiple modalities according to the planned topic, personal need, or preference. A Hyflex course presents the components of hybrid learning in a flexible model that gives students the option of attending scheduled class meetings face-to-face, online, or remote synchronously. Students can choose their manner of participation for each class meeting according to the planned topic, personal need, or preference. Please consider technology needs such as strong internet connection, camera/mic/speakers, etc. Additionally, a distraction free environment will be most conducive to learning.
